Fly on to Loisaba, a less visited and unique destination, before heading on to the Masai Mara, famed for the annual wildebeest migration and home to the big 5. Combining light aircraft flights and overnight stops in luxurious tented camps, this ultimate safari maximises every minute of your Kenya safari.

Day 01 – Nairobi Arrive to Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport by scheduled flight (flight booked by agent or on own arrangements). You are met inside the Arrivals Hall by our representative and fast tracked to clear customs and immigration formalities. He will assist you to the transfer vehicle for your transfer to the hotel. Dinner and overnight. Accommodation Hemingways Nairobi* in deluxe room on half board basis (excludes lunch, drinks laundry) includes filtered water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits

Hemingways Nairobi is set between Nairobi National Park and the foot of the Ngong Hills. A exclusive boutique hotel far from the bustle of central Nairobi. Day 02 – Nairobi to Amboseli National Park Following breakfast and your safari briefing, you depart to Nairobi's Wilson Airport. Fly by the exclusive SkySafari aeroplane to Amboseli National Park. You are met on arrival by the camp's vehicle and provided a shared game drive en route to the camp arriving for lunch. After some time to enjoy the camp's facilities, you have a shared afternoon game drive returning to the camp for dinner and overnight. Accommodation Elewana Tortilis Camp on full board basis including all meals, bottled water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits plus laundry

Tortilis is a classic luxury safari camp. It has unrivalled views of Kilimanjaro, rising out of the semi-arid bush studded plains – Africa's highest mountain, and the highest free standing mountain in the world. Winner of British Airways' prestigious eco-tourism award, Tortilis pioneered low impact, high comfort tourism. Guests have access to a private 30,000 acre conservancy facing the mountain; and can enjoy walks with experienced Masai guides, bush breakfasts and sundowners. Tortilis is famous for Northern Italian cuisine based on original family recipes.

Day 03 – Amboseli National Park Start the day with a shared early morning game drive followed by a bush breakfast. Continue game viewing arriving at the camp at midday. Following lunch and time to enjoy the camp's facilities, you head out for a guided bush walk. Then head to a lookout point for a scenic sundowner. You have a private dinner at the camp and overnight. Accommodation Elewana Tortilis Camp on full board basis including all meals, bottled water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits plus laundry

Day 04 – Amboseli National Park to Loisaba Conservancy, Laikipia Following breakfast, you have a shared morning game drive enroute to the airstrip. Fly by the SkySafari aircraft to Loisaba Conservancy. Following your VIP welcome and briefing about the conservancy, you game view en route to the camp arriving for lunch. In the afternoon depart on a game drive or chose from a choice of activities offered by the camp. Relaxing drinks followed by dinner and overnight. Accommodation Elewana Loisaba Tented Camp on full board basis including all meals, bottled water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits plus laundry

Day 05 – Loisaba Conservancy, Laikipia Early morning bush walk with traditional Samburu guides. You return to the camp for breakfast and then have the rest of the morning at leisure. Following lunch at the camp, visit the anti-poaching sniffer dog team and depart on a game drive. Sundowners are enjoyed in the bush followed by dinner under the stars at the camp. Overnight. Accommodation Elewana Loisaba Tented Camp on full board basis including all meals, bottled water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits plus laundry

Day 06 – Loisaba Conservancy, Laikipia Your sharing morning options include a game drive, horse or camelback exploration, or bush running/trekking. This is followed by a bush breakfast. Then return to the camp for time to relax and enjoy as spa treatment. Shared afternoon game drive or visit to a Samburu village with dinner at the camp and overnight under the stars in your star bed. Those not wishing to spend the night under the stars remain at Loisaba Tented Camp. Accommodation Elewana Loisaba Star Beds or Elewana Loisaba Tented Camp on full board basis including all meals, bottled water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits plus laundry

Day 07 – Loisaba Conservancy to Masai Mara National Reserve Following breakfast at the camp, you game view en route to Loisaba airstrip. Fly by SkySafari aircraft to Masai Mara National Reserve. You are met on arrival by the camp's vehicle and provided a shared game drive en route to the camp arriving for lunch. After some time to enjoy the camp's facilities, you have a shared afternoon game drive ending with sundowners in the bush. Then return to the camp for dinner and overnight. Accommodation Sand River Masai Mara on full board basis including all meals, bottled water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits plus laundry

Day 08 – Masai Mara National Reserve Following an early breakfast at the camp, you depart for a full day of shared game viewing in Masai Mara National Reserve. A picnic hamper lunch is served in the bush. You return to the camp for dinner under the stars and overnight. Accommodation Sand River Masai Mara on full board basis including all meals, bottled water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits plus laundry

Sand River Masai Mara is an ideal destination, at any time of the year. For those wishing to enjoy exceptional game-viewing. The National Reserve is best known for its large concentration of big cats, such as leopard, cheetah and. Of course, lion. Even the dramatic arrival of the annual migration merely adds to an already abundant resident wildlife that awaits discovery.

Day 09 – Masai Mara National Reserve
Optional balloon safari – at supplement

You have an early start with a shared game drive arriving at your secluded bush breakfast. You then game view as you return to the camp for time at leisure and lunch. In the afternoon, you have your final shared game drive followed by sundowners in the bush. You enjoy a farewell dinner under the stars and overnight at the camp. Accommodation Sand River Masai Mara on full board basis including all meals, bottled water, juice, local beer, house wine by the glass and non-premium spirits plus laundry

The Masai Mara Game Reserve is often called simply "The Mara" - a Masai word meaning "mottled" - a reference to its patchy landscape. The Reserve covers 1,510 sq km (580 sq miles) and raises 1,500-2,170 meters above sea level. The terrain of the reserve is primarily grassland and riverine forest with clumps of distinctive acacia trees. It is about 270 km from the capital city Nairobi and takes about 5-6 hours by road or 40-45 minutes by flight.

Day 10 – Masai Mara National Reserve to Nairobi and depart
Following breakfast, you transfer to the airstrip for your SkySafari flight back to Nairobi's Wilson Airport. You are met on arrival and transferred to Four Points by Sheraton Nairobi Airport Hotel where you have use of a day room. Lunch (excludes drinks) is provided at the hotel. You then transfer to Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your departure flight. End of our services.
